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GENERAL INFORMATION

The Wyomissing Area School District will offer several enrichment and academic opportunities this summer.

<u>LOCATIONS</u>: Specific locations are listed with the course description. Camps will be held at West Reading Elementary Center (WREC) and the Junior Senior High School (JSHS).

REGISTRATION: The registration process will begin Monday, April 22, 2019 and will end on Friday, June 7. All registration forms will be available online at www.wyoarea.org. Summer classes are self-supporting and www.wyoarea.org. Summer classes are minimum of 6 participants to be held.

<u>CAMP CONFIRMATION</u>: Upon completion of your enrollment form, you will receive a confirmation via email that your enrollment has been processed. Following the June 7 deadline, if minimum enrollment requirements are met, confirmation emails will be sent to all participants.

FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE (unless the course is canceled due to low enrollment): Checks or money orders are to be made payable to the Wyomissing Area School District. Tuition must be paid in full at the time of registration. Fees will only be refunded if we cancel the class.

<u>ATTENDANCE:</u> Students are expected to be on time and in attendance for all activity sessions. Transportation will not be provided. It is up to the parent or guardian to secure transportation for each student. In the event of illness or any other unforeseeable absence, please contact either the instructor via email or the school office.

<u>CONDUCT & DRESS</u>: Students are expected to follow the same rules for Summer Camp classes as they do during the regular school year. SESSIONS 101: 20th Century Ethnomusicology

Ethnomusicology is the study of how music, culture, and communication are linked throughout history.
