Proposed Goals

- Move JSHS student start time to approximately 8:15
- Maintain WREC and WHEC start times similar to current schedules

Needs/Next Steps

- Provide communications and seek input from students, staff, and parents
- Collaborate with WAEA to discuss staff work day
- Revisit JSHS schedule to increase student participation in club activities and access to academic support or extension opportunities
- Consider a JSHS "Flex" period to meet student needs

Proposed Timeline

- February-April 2022 Focus groups, communication and collaboration with stakeholders
- May 2022 Consider Board approval of school start times for 2023-24 school year
- June 2022-July 2023 Organize school schedules, transportation services, employee schedules and PowerSchool scheduling program to support approved start times
- August 2023 Implement revised school start times for 2023-24 school year
